Over 2 billion people on earth eat insects for protein. The Gateway Bug explores how changing daily eating habits can feed humanity in an uncertain age, one meal at a time. Interviewing over 50 professionals from the UN, USDA, NRDC, to chef Andrew Zimmern and Shark Tank star Pat Crowley.

THE STORY

Following the rise and fall of edible insect start-ups in America, this documentary exposes America's disconnect with food as climate catastrophe, uncovering daily habits individuals can change to fix our broken food system.

Documenting the shifting American landscape of regulation, diet and agriculture from the front lines of climate-affected communities like Flint MI and Youngstown OH, we convert viewers into activists, igniting social change through education and empowerment. From witnessing the birth of the first American Edible Insect Coalition in Detroit we share interviews with over 50 leaders of industry.



From the UN to USDA, the NRDC and the Climate Foundation, to TV host / celebrity chef **Andrew Zimmern** (above) and Shark Tank star Pat Crowley, we reveal as yet unseen technology in Silicon Valley, commercial cricket farms in the rust belt, bug eating festivals keeping Austin weird and lawmakers on capitol hill. Recent studies show a global shift to an ento/plant-based diet would reduce mortality 10% and cut up to 70% of Greenhouse Gas emissions by 2050, The Gateway Bug shares the key towards a brighter future from an intimate insider's journey.

The Gateway Bug documentary was conceived in March 2015 and completed in January 2017 on a shoestring budget, a third of which was raised on Kickstarter in 2015, using personal equipment and driving across the country, relying on fellow filmmaker friends for crew.

THE DIRECTOR




